

# Leadership Berkeley Class of 2024

Thank you for applying to Leadership Berkeley. For us to process your application, we ask that you complete the application according to the following instructions:

- Complete the questions and add additional pages, as necessary. Please label each additional page with the question you are answering.
- Please note that application must be signed by both the applicant and his/her employer.

## <u>Selection</u> Considerations

Each Leadership Berkeley class is chosen to achieve balance in the class by ensuring diversity of race, gender, industry, professional backgrounds, and leadership experience. Classes are representative of our community and include participants who represent large and small businesses, the self-employed, and nonprofit organizations. Applications will be thoroughly reviewed.

Selection considerations include:

- Participation eligible to all individuals who live or work in the Greater Berkeley County area or a Berkeley Chamber member business in good standing
- Commitment to personal and professional growth
- Commitment and motivation to serve the community by assuming leadership roles in the voluntary and public sectors of our community
- Commitment to improving the community environment to favorably impact the economic development and quality of life in our community
- Length of time in the community

## **Program Tuition**

In addition to time and dedication, Leadership Berkeley requires a financial commitment. To keep the cost to a minimum for the participants, the program does receive some sponsorships from the business community for the program days, orientation, and graduation. Tuition and sponsorships cover all program costs including the two-day orientation, facilitator costs, materials and meals provided during each program day, graduation meal and any required transportation needs.

Tuition fee payments are final and are non-refundable once the applicant has accepted their spot in the class.

Tuition: \$1350.00 for Members and \$1,500.00 for Non-Members

## **Program Participant Responsibilities**

Leadership Berkeley provides its participants with the opportunity to engage in an exciting ten months of personal, professional and community exploration and it does require a time commitment.

The program begins with a two-day orientation in February. Classes meet for all-day "program days" on one Thursday of each month, usually the third Thursday, from March through October. Class members can miss a <u>total</u> of 8 hours per year, excluding the orientation, which is mandatory. A special graduation concludes the class in November.

To enrich the Leadership Berkeley experience and increase community engagement, in addition to the orientation and program days, a class project is required. The time commitment for the class project is dependent upon the participants. Participants who are unable to meet the requirements of the program will be dropped, with no refund. Following the completion of the program, participants are expected to stay involved in the organization, continually enhancing their Leadership experience, and helping to strengthen the program for the future.

## Time Commitment

Participation in Leadership Berkeley program requires a major time commitment. Participants are expected to attend ALL sessions. Emergency absences are reviewed on a one-on-one basis. *Schedule dates and sessions are subject to change.*
